The Treasurer's report was read by Jamie Harvey with a motion to accept by Bob Richter and Ed Stodola.

**Old Business:**

Connie Stodola called Brookcrest Fisheries to see if Dave Kussow had placed our order for fall fish stocking. They did not receive an order. Connie then placed the order for \$7500 to be delivered in the fall. Mike at Brookcrest said he would make sure to reserve the largest fish available. He also asked if we had applied for a permit with the DNR as he spoke to them recently and they indicated that they planted walleye in the lake this spring. We may need to change the order from ½ & ½ to all perch. Connie will contact Mike back with the answer as soon as we find out from the DNR.

Mark Macha has the updated GPS maps of the new fish cribs ready for hand out, and presented them to the club. Connie will keep this on file also.

A recap of the Chicken Tips and Toys Banquet showed that a profit of \$4,748.00 was made. Thank you to all who helped in the event.

**New Business:**

The Labor Day week-end Apparel Sale will be on for Saturday and Sunday. Connie Szczepanski will set up on the Kwik Stop Site. Emily Macha has volunteered to help her on Saturday. Connie has turned in over \$2000 in sales to the treasury and has orders yet to fill. Thank you Connie for a job very well done!

The Dairyfest Parade will be held on Sept 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 am. Connie Stodola has called to register our parade entry. She has also ordered 1000 American

Flags to be passed out on the parade route. Gary Vizelka has contacted the American Legion and they already have a float prepared for the Vets to ride on. We will still decorate with Red White and Blue. Gary will pick up the streamers and balloons. A special committee meeting will be held on Tues at 7:00 pm at VIZ's to get the band and float preparation finalized. The committee consists of Gary Vizelka, Mike Wirz, Ed Stodola and Ron Asp.

The lake Algae problem was again discussed. Gary Vizelka contacted DNR warden Mike Stahl. Mike said he has nothing to do with water management and we need to contact the Peshtigo office. Jamie Harvey will call to find out if something can be done and if other lakes have the same problem. Mike Wirz stressed that the problem is bad and that the DNR should address it soon. Causes discussed were water levels being low, lack of rain, and other factors. Also discussed were the fish maggots that have been found. This seems to be an ongoing event that takes care of itself.

For the fall pheasant planting a committee of Mark Macha (chairman), Bob Richter, and Earl Macha is in place. We will contact Mark when the Suring Sportsman's Club is ready.

Ice Derby 2009 plans were discussed. Gary Vizelka contacted all the merchants that were major donators last year and has the list ready for the ticket printing. \$1500 first prize the club, \$500 second prize the club, Don Bader of Northwoods Sporting Goods along with Gary Vizelka of VIZ's Bar are planning a \$600 sport fishing package. Bob White \$125 certificate, Yancy Powersports a pontoon rental, Romy's Holiday Inn a 22 marlin gun. Peshtigo National Bank two \$100 savings bonds. Oconto County Sportsman's Alliance is donating 10 fishing poles with a value of \$450. Connie Stodola will call Associated Bank as they did request last year that they wanted to be put on the ticket too. Gary would like to get the ticket order out within 2 weeks. Jamie will talk to Karen Richter about the State raffle permit number. Ten thousand tickets will be ordered. Jamie Harvey announced that her business, Sharper Image will be donating 2 bikes for a kids fishing contest. Thank you Jamie, as this will be a big hit. Volunteer lists will be started by the next meeting so that we can sign up on the job list for the derby. Connie Stodola will have this ready. Discussion on where to have the derby was held. Land, (choice of 2 sites) or ice. It is preferred to hold it on land and we are never sure of ice conditions each year. Earl Macha has graciously said yes to using either site, the Kwik Stop parking lot or the old Round Roof site. Thank you Earl for this donation.

Connie Stodola asked when we would like to invite the Gillett college student, Mike Jones, to speak at a meeting. The decision to ask him to attend our October meeting at Parkway Golf Course, as they have a better set up to show pictures. Connie will contact him. This is the student the club help sponsor, on a summer study trip to Europe and Iceland.

Our web site person, Eric Chessman, has had a bad cycle accident but is back to work. We wish him well and a speedy recovery.

Our next meeting will be held on September 25<sup>th</sup> at Wescott Lake. The board will meet at 6:30 with the regular meeting at 7:30 pm.
