**June 26<sup>th</sup> Meeting Minutes**

The meeting was called to order by President Dave Kussow with 35 members present. A motion to accept the Secretary's Report as printed was made by Emily Macha and Judy Jandt. The Treasurer's Report was given by Jamie Harvey with a motion by Ron Asp and Mark Macha to approve.

Old Business:

The Wheel Chair Accessible Dock report was given by Bob Jandt. The pathway construction is ready to go, but the Town of Brazeau has become aware of a sewer pipe problem.
