October 30th, 2008 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by President Gary Vizelka with 27 members present. A motion was made by Ed Stodola and Marj Keshemberg to approve the September meeting minutes as printed. Jamie Harvey read the Treasurers report. A motion was made by Judy Jandt and Ed Stodola to accept.

Old Business:

The pheasant planting report was given by Mark Macha. One hundred and fifty birds were released. Those helping were Earl Macha, Mark, & Autumn, Arlyn Libal, Bob Jandt, Bob Oseland, and Bob Richter. We were allowed extra birds as the Breed Sportsman's club canceled their order. Some of the birds were planted on new land. We will keep the same hunting maps available. Thank you volunteers for helping to keep this yearly tradition going.

The dock report was given by Bob Jandt. He and Arlyn Libal have prepared the dock for winter by pulling the posts and tethering the dock to shore. Bob also spoke to Gerald Kempka of the Brazeau Board and the sewer line has not been fixed yet. They are still waiting for this repair to be done so the town can move forward and finish the project. Bob will attend their next board meeting.

New Business:

Fish Stocking permit has been obtained. We will not be able to plant any perch this year per DNR orders. Connie Stodola called Brookcrest and changed the order to all walleye. The DNR says they did plant fish in Kelly Lake last spring. They would like to

see that Kelly Lake be a lake of natural reproduction. They would only allow us to plant walleye, bass, or northern. Gary will contact them and see if someone could attend a meeting the beginning of next year to discuss these changes.

Ice derby plans. The posters and raffle tickets are here. Packets of collection sites were handed out to Mark Macha for Coleman and Kelly Lake area, Merrilee Libal for Suring, Jamie Harvey and Emily Macha for Lena & Spruce, and Don Wirz for Oconto Falls. We did not hear a reply from Leslie Fisher yet about the Gillett area. Judy Jandt collected prizes from Parkway Golf Course and Connie Stodola collected a signed & # print for special raffle from Vorpahl's Business Services.

Earl Macha has spoken to Pat Thomson and he has agreed to make the chicken booyah again this year. Prices were discussed for food items. A motion was made by Mark Macha and Pat Pawlak to go with \$3 for burgers \$2.50 for brats, \$2 for booyah, \$1 for coffee and hot cocoa, and \$2 per can for beer. All were in favor. Connie will make price posters for food sales. Emily Macha has asked Karen Seamon and Frank Stahl if they would do the bloody mary bar again this year. They said they could set up from 8:00 to 11:00. The trailer will need to be cleaned prior to the derby. Dick Pawlak asked Roger Schuetpeltz to use his sound system. Bacons and Sausages will need to be ordered for the tent raffles. Arlyn Libal will get some prices for the next meeting. Last year we went through 21 bacons and 6 sausages. Jamie Harvey said that frozen shrimp will be donated also for the raffles. Club apparel will be sold by Emily Macha. Connie Szczepanski will have the price list ready for her. Aprons have been ordered and will be here in time. Connie also showed us winter jackets that could be ordered. We will raffle off a Denim jacket also.

The deer hunting contest will be held from November 22 through the 30th. Only club members can participate. Memberships must be purchased prior to season to qualify. Deer may be registered at

VIZ'S Bar or the Kelly Lake Kwik Stop. Winners will be drawn at the December meeting.

Pat Pawlak reported that a banquet will be held on Jan 31st at Romy's, hosted by Wade Jeske of the Lena Swamp Club. Money raised at this event goes to several projects including the youth deer and turkey hunt. Connie Stodola and Emily Macha made a motion to donate \$500 to this cause. Pat will contact Wade to see if he would like the cash or a prize donation.
